## School End of Year Examination Conditions for Senior Students 2016:

- You do not need to come to school if you do not have an assessment.
- Unless you have consecutive sessions, it is expected that you leave the school grounds and only return for your next assessment. If you must remain at school then you must go to Rm13 & 14 for silent study. You will be asked to leave if not quiet.
- Most curriculum areas have an assessment activity. This may be written, practical, oral or aural, or a combination of any of these methods. If you are uncertain, check with your subject teacher.
- Some curriculum areas will have more than 1 assessment opportunity at this time.
- Wear full school uniform to, from, and at all assessments. Normal school rules about uniform apply.
- Exam sessions begin at 9.00 am and 1.00pm, unless otherwise stated on the exam timetable. Check very carefully what time your exams begins.
- Bring all necessary equipment to the exam; paper, pens, calculator, ruler, compass, protractor, etc. enclosed in a clear plastic bag. Do not bring your school bag or other possessions/valuables. If you do bring bags, they must be left at the front of the exam room.
- You may be seated in an ordered fashion similar to NCEA external assessments.
- Arrive at your exam at least 15 minutes before it starts. You must stay in the exam venue for the first 40 minutes. You will not be allowed entry if you arrive later than 30 minutes after the exam commences. You may not leave during the last 15 minutes of the exam.
- You may not eat in the exam rooms. Drinking of water from a clear plastic sipper bottle is permitted.
- If you miss an assessment through illness or other emergency event, you must first inform the school office (03) 21 69 039. When you arrive back at school you must then complete a "Missed Assessment Form" and produce a medical certificate or note from your parents/caregiver.
- NZQA Exam rules. You may not:
  - Copy from another student
  - Borrow equipment
  - Communicate either verbally or in any other manner with other students.
  - Follow the instructions of Exam supervisors at all times.
- No use or possession of cell phones is permitted whatsoever. Place your cell phone in the container at the front of the exam room. Put your name on a post it notes so it can be identified as your cell phone.
- If you have a clash with any of your exams, see Mr du Mez as soon as possible and no later than Friday the 17<sup>th</sup> August.
